

Minutes of the Kingsboro Civic League

The Kingsboro Civic League meeting for Tuesday, July 19, 2022 was called to order by President, Ron Pier at 6:30 PM at the Constant House. There were 12 members present. The residents included Ron Pier, Linda Jean McClure, Carol McClellan, Rex and Peg Bailor, Karen Scott, Jill Gwaltney. Bob Grady, Steven Peters, Tom and Cindy Ashley and Sherry Matthews. No guests were present.

Minutes from the last meeting held June 21, 2020 meeting were read and approved. Treasurer, Bob Grady reported \$ 435 in Treasury but not currently in a bank account. With our inactivity during Pandemic shutdown, bank fees would have consumed a lot of our funds, so Bob was just holding it until activity resumed. Bob Grady and Ron discussed having two signatures on the KCL account and they will take care of that.

Motions and seconds were made to keep all board members the same and this was approved by members.

President Ron said he had been in touch with Terry Barona about the sign in Coulbourn Park. He also said Councilman Donnie Goldberg could not make it to this meeting but let him know if any issues needed to be passed on to him for his assistance.

President Ron Pier called for vote on Article 5 in By-Laws. Articles A, B & C to remain the same, but add Article D to state "A member shall be dropped from the roles of membership in the event that it is the opinion of the membership, expressed by a majority vote at a regular meeting, that the member's conduct has brought discredit to the League, members or any elected officers". This was seconded by Bob and approved. A quorum was in attendance for this vote and a notice was announced at a prior meeting. By-Laws are online at KCLLeague.com.

Discussion was held about young boys throwing rocks onto doorsteps and porches, mostly on Highland Ave. Homeowner has talked with them, but Ron would like to try to get Suffolk Police at our next meeting to discuss this and other issues in our neighborhoods. Carol and Ron praised Suffolk Police for such a large area to cover. Members also questioned if mosquito control had started coming through neighborhoods. No one was sure.

Vice President Carol McClellan brought up discussion about Horton Wreath Society donations. All donations to them stay here. Donations through Amazon Smile go to National Cemetery Wreath Society. Bob Grady added comments and said the VFW and American Legion help with flags and wreaths. Carol had envelopes for donations for anyone interested. Bob Grady collected dues from almost everyone present.

President Ron Pier said he would keep the website up to date since there is some interest. He also reminded everyone of National Night out coming up Tuesday, August 2. Even though our Civic League is not sponsoring an event, we should check out and support others.
