

Minutes of the Kingsboro Civic League

The Kingsboro Civic League meeting for Tuesday, June 21, 2022 was called to order by President, Ron Pier at 6:30 PM at the Constant House. There were 6 residents present. The residents included Ron Pier, Linda Jean McClure, Carol McClellan, Eddie Sharp, Steven Peters and Sherry Matthews. No guests were present.

Minutes from the last meeting held March 9, 2020 meeting were read and approved with the correction of Mark Furlo's last name. Treasurer's report was not available as Treasurer was not in attendance. Ron Called Bob Grady to be sure he was not on the way and Bob said he was okay, but could not attend. Discussion was held that there needs to be two signations on the bank account in case Bob was not available.

President Ron Pier said Article 5 in By-Laws needs updating. This was discussed at the February 2020 meeting and Article 13 in the by-laws require a quorum to vote and a notice at a prior meeting. By-Laws are online at KCLLeague.com. KCL will try to vote on this at the July meeting.

Mr. Furio had emailed Ron and Sherry about Park. Plans are in place to replace the playground next Fall and Mr. Furlo would like feedback from KCL if any other cleanup/additions needed in Coulbourn Park. Discussion was held that weeds and undergrowth were under sign and sign needed to be painted or replaced. Ron will respond to the email.

Discussion was held about the guardrail alongside Constance coming up to Katherine St. Painting appears complete except for section in bushes and trees at end. A couple of members talked with the artist who was from Virginia Beach. Paint and payment to her were funded by a grant through Keep Suffolk Beautiful and Suffolk Art League. The street side shows a design and the backside was painted silver and sealed. All agreed it was definitely an improvement over the drab, rusty brown.

Discussion was brought up about cars parking on wrong side of Highland Ave. Residents should call police to issue warnings to parking offenders. Also, house on Highland was broken in to. Resident was encouraged to file a police report, even if less than \$ 500 missing. Also KCL would like to discuss with police about duplex on Katherine that is behind guardrail.

Ron announced that dues will be due at the July meeting and they are \$25 per household or \$ 12.50 for single residents

Next meeting will be Tuesday, July 19, 2022. Remember to pay dues and vote on by-laws update. Meeting adjourned at 7:05PM after a motion made by Carol and seconded by Eddie.
